



Diamond Parent Duties

Before a game or practice

- Make sure the pitching distance is correct for your team.
- Find 2-3 people to help place the portable baseball pitching mound in place at the proper pitching distance (This applies to PeeWee and Mosquito baseball only)
- Make sure all base distances are correct for your team.
- Chalk the foul lines and batters boxes with the flour provided
- Power up the scoreboard. Power button is located on the top of the scoreboard. (Supreme, Lynco and Longhorn Fields).

After a game or practice

- Find 2-3 people to help remove the portable baseball pitching mound and place it back in the stand. (This applies to PeeWee and Mosquito baseball only)
- Pick up any small garbage in and around the diamond to help keep our paid maintenance costs down.
- Sweep out the dugout.
- Ensure the scoreboard is turned off. The power off button is located on the scoreboard remote. (Supreme, Lynco and Longhorn Fields)

After a tournament or weekend game

- If the garbage is full, take the garbage to the dumpsters located at the West Central Events Centre.

Note: If you come across a repair needed at your diamond, and you do not feel comfortable fixing yourself, or if the flour for chalking lines needs to be restocked, please notify the Kindersley Minor Ball Maintenance Coordinator. The Maintenance Coordinator contact info is available at kmsports.ca under the Ball Board section.

If the Diamond Parent from the team before is not fulfilling their duties, please report this to the KMB Maintenance Coordinator.

Upon taking this position, you will remove the volunteer hours for 1 child, who plays on the team that you are assigned as Diamond Parent.
