



## ***Welcome to the Kindersley Skating Club!***

The Kindersley Skating Club offers the following programs for the 2019-2020 skating season:

### **CanSkate (Age 3+ as of December 31, 2019):**

Tuesday & Thursday afternoons OR

Monday & Thursday mornings

Learn to skate program for beginners of any age that teaches the fundamental movement and basic skills. Focuses on balance, agility and control. This is a feeder program to all other Skate Canada programs.

### **Pre-PowerSkate (Age 3+ as of December 31, 2019):**

Tuesday & Thursday afternoons OR

Monday & Thursday mornings

Learn to skate program for children not yet playing hockey but want to develop skating abilities. Focuses on balance, control, power, agility, speed and endurance skills, all of which are especially important for hockey players.

### **Advanced CanSkate:**

Monday & Wednesday afternoons

Skaters that have taken CanSkate and would like to further develop their skills focusing on figure skating.

### **Pre-Star:**

Monday & Wednesday afternoons

Transition from Advanced CanSkate to StarSkate. Must have completed all CanSkate Levels.

Monday & Wednesday afternoons

### **StarSkate (Junior/Senior):**

Monday & Wednesday evenings

Opportunity for skaters to develop fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of Ice Dancing, Skills, Free Skate, Stroking and Interpretive Skating.

### **Synchro:**

A specialized discipline of skating involving a group of skaters performing various group formations and maneuvers. Must have completed all CanSkate levels or equivalent skating skills.

Monday evenings

As skaters can progress at their own rate, there is no specific age range for each program. Coaches will assess each skater's ability and place them accordingly.



### **FUNDRAISING EXPECTATIONS:**

The Kindersley Skating Club and Kindersley Minor Sports relies on fundraising to help subsidize our programs and keep your fees at a minimum. Examples of where the money is needed include (but not limited to) CanSkate program aids, coaching aids, program assistants, music, etc. Fundraising initiatives for 2019/2020 include selling:

1. KMS Raffle Tickets (\$100 per child) – if your child sold tickets for Minor Ball, you have completed your obligation and do not have to sell for skating.
2. Skate Canada Tickets – each family pre-pays \$100.00 for one book of tickets, which you will receive at the AGM in September. Books (regardless if you sell them) must be returned no later than December 15<sup>th</sup>
3. Carnival Raffle Tickets – each family pre-pays \$25.00 for one book of tickets, which you will receive in February. Each book must be returned no later than March 6<sup>th</sup>

### **VOLUNTEER EXPECTATIONS:**

As members of Kindersley Skating Club, it is the expectation of each parent/guardian to volunteer their time working at different events throughout the season. The Annual Carnival takes place in March in which we will be calling on parents/guardians to assist in putting on this event. Watch for emails closer to the date! In addition, a small costume expense may be incurred for your child's group.

The Kindersley Skating Club Executive Board is always looking for new members to join our team of volunteers. Please let us know if you are interested in becoming a board member or would like more information on the responsibilities of our Skating Board.
